 3. Rebar indicated as set have metal caps inscribed "Kilburn B. Swallow, PLS # 2217".
 4. Monuments set and found at the shorefront indicated on the parcels surveyed and proposed to be conveyed shown hereon are near the high-water mark in a practical location. The land to be conveyed will extend to the normal low-water mark, encompassed by an extension of the sideline boundaries shown and along the frontage of surveyed parcels along the normal low-water mark subject to restrictions of record.
 5. All field work was performed with Topcon Hiper V RTK GPS, and Leica TS 12 Robotic Total Station.
 6. A description for the fifty-foot-wide right of way has been prepared and issued to client.
 7. Some geographical features shown have been digitized from 2018 USDA aerial photos.
